Synod of the Rocky Mountains Annual Coordinating Team Meeting

The Synod of the Rocky Mountains Presbyterian Women Coordinating Team met in Denver at the Holiday Inn Jan. 19-21, 2018. This was the new location of the meeting, which was previously held at the Loretto Retreat Center. It was a productive weekend with much business held, including the election and installation of new leaders. They include: Kathy Lundberg, PWS Member-at-Large to coordinate the 2019 PWS Gathering, Vicki Terry-PWS Vice Moderator, Alice Koerner, PWS Racial Ethnic Member-at-Large, Lynn Erickson, PWS Search Committee Member and Gail Heimbuck, PWS CCT Representative. These leaders terms will be from 2018-2021. Sharon Cely, Vice Moderator, Alice Koerner, Search Committee moderator, Dorothy Peay, Racial Ethnic Member-at-Large, and Vicki Terry, PWS CCT Representative were recognized and thanked as outgoing officers.

It was voted to have a Rocky Mountain Coordinating Team Google network, with documents, including bylaws, minutes and job descriptions. Current job descriptions were updated to alter and clarify some responsibilities.

It was voted to hold the annual CT meeting on Friday, Jan. 18, 2019 at 10:00 am via Zoom. Elections and budget discussions will be part of the meeting. The next CT meeting will be held in conjunction with the Synod Gathering in the summer of 2019. Kathy Lundberg will organize the Synod Gathering which will be held in Sheridan, WY. The following CT meeting will be held in Denver in 2020 and Vicki Terry will be in charge of arrangements for that meeting.

Great fellowship was enjoyed throughout the weekend. Kathy shared the Global Exchange trip to Indonesia with us and looks forward to sharing it again at our PWP of Wyoming Spring Gathering. Our offering from the worship service at the synod meeting went to Cathy Chang, a mission co worker in Indonesia and to the One Small Gift mission project of gift cards for ministries in Indiana, Kentucky and West Virginia.

It was wonderful to be back at the Synod CT meeting and I am honored to be representing the Synod on the PW Churchwide Coordinating Team. My term will begin after my installation at Churchwide Gathering in August. Please feel free to give me your input on PW or questions about PW programming and missions that you may have. Greetings All,

I have just returned from the 2018 PW Synod Annual Planning Meeting in Denver, CO. From Marilynn Collins opening welcome remarks and devotions to the closing song and prayer, our time spent together was very productive and several items were accomplished. I am assuming that you all will receive the minutes so graciously taken by Mary Lee Hooks so I will not focus on the particulars.

In general we reviewed and updated the by-laws and the job descriptions. We spent a great deal of time reviewing the financials and budget for 2018-2019 and noted a downward trend to the donations received from the presbyteries. The Global Exchange funding was the exception to this. The search committee presented their findings and made nominations. Through icebreaker games and sharing of meals we shared our lives as Christian women growing together. On Saturday morning I presented the Global Exchange Program on Indonesia with slides and artifacts that I collected while I was there. I used Sharon as my model for "how to put a sari on" which was fun.

As I have extensive catering experience facilitating large groups, I offered to research the possibility of hosting the PW Synod Gathering in 2019 at the Holiday Inn in Sheridan, WY. I was elected as Member at Large and tasked to collect information about availability and cost for having the Gathering in Sheridan. I plan to meet with the Catering Director this week and then emailing the details to the Committee later this week. I did not accept the position of Vice Moderator which usually sets up the Gathering along with the two committee meetings throughout the year.
